

INADEQUATE COACHES COMPENSATION

- DEKALB COUNTY IS THE LOWEST PAID COUNTY IN GREATER ATLANTA
- COACHES GET PAID AN AVERAGE OF \$1/HOUR

RESULT IS HIGH TURNOVER LACK OF CONSISTENCY WEAKENS PROGRAMS FEWER COACHES PER TEAM COMPARED TO COMPETITION





LACK OF TRANSPORTATION

- GROUPS WITHOUT FACILITIES ON SITE MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN TRANSPORTATION TO PRACTICE OFTEN RELYING ON UPPER CLASSMEN TO DRIVE
- ALL 63 GROUPS SHARE COUNTY BUSES TO GET TO COMPETITIONS SO BUSES OFTEN AREN'T AVAILABLE
- STUDENTS MISS INSTRUCTIONAL TIME, OFTEN LEAVING AS EARLY AS 1PM, SO BUSES CAN RETURN TO SCHOOL FOR REGULAR ROUTES





PARENTS AND COACHES ARE ENDURING THE COST

GROUPS ARE FORCED TO RAISE PARTICIPATION DUES RANGING FROM **\$200 – \$750** PER STUDENT

ONE FAMILY WITH 3 STUDENTS IN 7 DIFFERENT EXTRACURRICULARS COULD PLAY AS MUCH AS \$3,000

THAT SAME FAMILY, IF ASKED TO PATRICIATE IN JUST TWO FUNDRAISERS PER ACTIVITY, COULD SUPPORT **42 FUNDRAISERS**
